



Scanning a chapter or chapters of Printed library books and materials ranked the highest preferred material type garnering 40%, followed by E-Books (27%).




As shown in the graph, August has the highest number of requests with 53 or 19.27% responses, next is March with 41 request or 14.91%.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS PER AREAS/SECTIONS OF THE LIBRARY

❖ TECHNICAL SERVICES SECTION

- A total of 233 volumes of library books were accessioned, collated, stamped ownership marks and assigned barcode stickers.
- 294 titles and 334 volumes of newly acquired books were cataloged, classified and encoded in the Destiny Library Database.
- There was a total of 226 volumes of new books were mounted with call number labels, 60 volumes typed and mounted with books properties, 217 volumes covered with plastic and 1,484 volumes tagged with RFID labels ready for delivery to the different sections of the library for circulation.
- A total of 1,675 entries of books were checked and 1,675 entries were edited/reflected in the library database.
- 24,340 copy records for Sub-location updates and 24,316 copy records were also updated as to its Call No. Prefix against the library database.
- A total of 6,517 entries of books were checked, edited/reflected against the library database to ensure accuracy and consistency of call no., circulation type and sub-location for FY 2022.






